- * Reasonable funeral expenses of a deceased member of:
 - ➤ Volunteer Fire Company
 - ➤ Volunteer Fire Company Auxiliary
 - ➤ Volunteer Ambulance and Rescue
- Member for the purpose of this benefit is one who has served as an active member for at least 10 years.
- ❖ As of 1-1-05, amount not to exceed \$7000.00
- ❖ In order to process a claim, a Funeral Expense Form needs to be completed. To obtain the form, please see our website at:

- ❖ With that form, a copy of the Death Certificate and a copy of the itemized funeral bill.
- ❖ If the applicant wants the payment to go directly to the funeral home, an Assignment of Benefit needs to be included. This form is also available on our website:
