



Personal Documentation

In order to obtain a federal identification compliant Delaware driver's license on or after 7/1/10, a driver must present one-time validation of full legal name, date of birth, and citizenship/legal presence in the US.

A federal identification compliant Delaware driver license or identification card is distinguishable by the gold star in the upper right corner, and a non-compliant card is distinguishable by the phrase "Not for Federal Identification" printed in the upper margin.




If a retiring employee in any Delaware Public Employees Retirement System pension plan has a Delaware driver's license issued on or after 7/1/10 that shows a gold star in the upper right corner (indicating federal identification compliant), he/she will not be required to provide proof of legal name (provided the current name is the same as that on the DE driver's license), date of birth or citizenship.
