## Benefits Calculator Update! <br> Expanded Survivor Options

The Benefits Calculator on the Office of Pensions website, www.delawarepensions.com, has been updated to include expanded survivor options in most plans administered by Delaware Public Employees'
Retirement System. These options affect the following plans and are for those members with an effective date of retirement on or after January 1, 2015:

State Employees Pension Plan
County and Municipal General Plan
County and Municipal Police \& Firefighter Plan
State Judiciary Plan
New State Police Plan

## Survivor Options

- No reduction of pension to provide a $50 \%$ survivor's pension
- Pension reduced by $2 \%$ to provide a $66.67 \%$ survivor's pension
- Pension reduced by $3 \%$ to provide a $75 \%$ survivor's pension
- Pension reduced by $6 \%$ to provide a $100 \%$ survivor's pension

After service and salary information is entered and the Compute button is clicked, the expanded options display in the Monthly Earnings Benefit Information section:

Helpful Hint:
Do not use commas in the combined highest 3 year compensation field. For example, type 100000 instead of 100,000 .


Prior to January 1, 1997 - Years $10-$ Months 0.0 -
Affer December 31, 1996 - Years $20-$ Months 0.0 -
COMBINED HIGHEST 3 YEAR COMPENSATION: $\$ 120000$

Your total creditable compensation is the total compensation paid to you during the three periods of 12 consecutive months during which your compensation was the highest.
